It was very revealing that the police, who were already there, acted as though everything was as it should be $\hat{a}\in \mathbb{C}$

In the former chess championâ \in TMs opinion, it was clear that some act of provocation had been prepared. â \in œTwo men started to hassle me, demanding I go away without causing any trouble. But they were sent away by the Mothers of Beslan. After this, an impromptu meeting took place, which was interrupted when these people, who had taken up positions that made it easier to aim at us, started throwing eggs and ketchup,â \in • he said.
